Bag Lunch Donation Program

About the Bag Lunch Ministry:

St. Vincent de Paul Emergency Shelters 125 bag lunches daily. Oftentimes, when a guest arrives for their first time at the shelter, they are provided with a bag lunch. Bag lunches may also be provided to guests if they have a medical condition such as diabetes or pregnancy. Also, if a guest misses a meal for reasons such as an appointment, or work, they are given a bag lunch. By providing bag lunches, you are helping us to accompany our guests one person at a time, which is intrinsic to our mission.



Bag Lunch Requirements:

- One hearty meat sandwich: 2 ounces of meat on bread without condiments (no PB&J please) (condiment packets may be placed in bag, but are not required)
- A drink: small, bottled water or juice box.
- 2 snacks: a salty snack and a sweet snack or a piece of fruit
- Date: Every bag must be dated with the date it was prepared.

Please Remember:

- This could be someone's main meal of the day, so think about putting together a meal that you would like to eat.
- If you are using thinly sliced meat, please make sure you have at least two ounces.
- The bag lunches are refrigerated for a period of time so items like bananas and peanut butter/jelly are not recommended.
- An appropriate inspirational note or greeting in the bag is a nice touch but is absolutely not required.
- Please avoid preparing bagged lunches with expired or moldy items. If mold is in one bagged lunch, it
 can spread throughout our food supply. We cannot serve any items that have mold.
